## Notes

- longitude lines intersect at poles
- from side view you can't see every longitude line / time zone

Prime Meridian $\left(0^{\circ}\right)=$ Greenwich Meridian
$180^{\circ}=$ International Date Line (opposite side of $0^{\circ}$ )

## On a globe:

Each line of longitude is $15^{\circ}$ apart or 1 hour apart

When working with time zones remember:
Left is less!
