

Aim: What are 2 types of severe weather?

## hurricanes

- 1. tropical cyclones (low pressure) mT air masses
- 2. storm track is guided by planetary winds
- 3. fueled by evaporating seawater
- 4. die out when they move over land
- 5. calm eye near center of storm
  - eye wall has most severe winds/precipitation
- 6. storm surge winds cause rising of the sea level and coastal flooding
- 7. hurricane season is late summer (July November)



## tornadoes

- 1. form when a cP collides with an mT (central U.S. is tornado alley)
- 2. starts with a very low pressure thunderstorm that creates twisting winds
- 3. highest windspeeds on Earth (200-300 mph)
- 4. tornado season spring to early summer (April June)
