


Aim:



Longshore Drift -


movement of sand parallel to the shoreline as waves strike the beach at an angle



Jetties and Groins -

man-made walls built perpendicular to the beach to try and slow the effects of longshore drift

change the coastal landscape by preventing sand from moving down shore





<u>sandbars</u> – waves pull sand away from the shoreline and builds up under water

<u>barrier island</u> – forms when a sandbar accumulates enough sand to rise above sea level (Jones Beach Island, Fire Island)
